An activity for 2 - 8 students.

Are you ready to take up the call? We're looking for innovative ideas that can turn into mahi! Just come up with a way to support a programme or initiative in your local community and you could win one of four \$2,500 prizes to see it come to life.

STEP 1: INVESTIGATE

Get together as a group and investigate a charity or community group that could use your help. You will need to email them and ask:

- What does the charity or community group do?
- What do they need funding for?
- How can your group support them?

STEP 2: BRAINSTORM

Brainstorm ideas for how your donation of the \$2,500 prize money could help the charity or community group. You can use your own ideas, the ideas of the charity or community group or a combination of the two. To help your planning and costings, you can use tools and resources at sortedinschools.org.nz

STEP 3: GET PLANNING

Complete Sections 1-3 on the following pages to outline how you would donate prize money of \$2,500 your chosen charity or community group.

STEP 4: SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY

Ask your teacher to submit your application and supporting document (outlining the Sorted in Schools resources you used, and the emails from the charity or community group). Double check all steps above to make sure you have everything together.
