



What are the learning objectives?

- To develop important financial knowledge and skills needed post-secondary school for both school leavers and their whānau
- To apply knowledge through different case-study scenarios to make solid money and financial decisions.

Who is it for?

It is designed for students who are working towards NZ curriculum level 7 and 8.

What do I need?

Students needs a computer / chromebook or a handheld device such as tablet.

What are the resources provided?

This activity includes following resource materials to be provided.

- **Sort it out Booklets:** These four activity booklets provide students with the information they need to make informed decisions about buying a vehicle, funding their studies, working, and budgeting.
- **Sort it out Scenario interactive:** This scenario-based activity can be used to apply students' new knowledge to different situations and help them make the best money choices.
- **Sort it out Recap quiz:** This set of quizzes provides students with an opportunity to test their knowledge about money they have gained from the four topics in the booklet resources.

How can I use it?

- This resource is designed as a cross-curricular resource, supporting all the Sorted themes
- This resource can be used for whole-class instruction and directed teaching for schools
- This resource can also be used as home learning activities that can be done with whānau/parents
